Dear Members,

After another successful year the 2024 season is quickly ending. I have a few announcements to bring to your attention.

- ➤ Our annual meeting date is November 12, 2024, at the Elk's Club, at 7:00 PM. At the meeting we receive several manager and officer reports. Most importantly will elect 3 people to fill 3 expiring Board of Director seats. Kris VanWagner will not be returning. After 12 years of service Ernie Charelston will also not be returning. Over Ernie's 12 years of service, he has served as Secretary for 6 years and Treasurer for 3 years. During his entire term he served on many committees, but his main service has been on the House Committee. Ernie has volunteered for many projects and assisted in cooking when shorthanded. Thanks to you both.
- ➤ Over the last 16 years your restaurant and bar have been managed by Jamie Steinrotter. She has been a very loyal and hard-working employee. After some reflection and thought she has requested we find a new manager. As she steps back from managing, she is looking forward to returning next year as a bartender and server. Please take the time to thank her for her hard work and dedication.
- At the meeting on November 12^{th,} Kelli Hitchman (Chair of Nominating Committee) will be nominating Rob Bicknell, Marc Compeau and Chris Johnson to serve on the BODs to fill the vacancies for 3-year terms.
- ➤ The restaurant will close and cease service on October 24, 2024.
- The last day for the Proshop and course to be open and full service is October 31, 2024. In the past we have allowed access to golf carts. After some discussion we have decided to not allow access to our leased carts after the course is closed. Last year we experienced people without cart passes and even nonmembers using the carts. Some concerns about liability and potential damage requires us to limit access until we open in 2025. However, members can still and play when weather permits. As a reminder, please respect the course by not walking/playing the course when the temperatures are near or at freezing as that activity can cause unwanted damage to the turf.
- ➤ Over the winter the Proshop will receive a badly needed facelift. The facility will be slightly expanded. New windows and doors, flooring, ceiling, counter will upgrade the facility. We will begin the removal of the debris in early November. As always, we encourage any members who wish to donate to this project to feel free to participate.

Immediately after the annual meeting we will hold a Board of Directors meeting to elect officers. We are very excited about the next chapter for the club in 2025.
